1. Fill out Application form below **completely** and return in mail, or fax the application to the Board of Elections and Registration Office at: (770) 528-2458 or (770) 528-2519.
2. You may have the Application form delivered in person to the Cobb County Board of Elections at: 736 Whitlock Ave., Suite 400.
3. Ballots will be mailed starting August 31, 2011.
4. When you receive your ballot, fill it out completely and return it according to the instructions on the ballot.

- * Closed Friday, September 2nd and Monday, September 5th

Check ONLY ONE of the following reasons, if applicable:

No Reason: You are not required to provide a reason to vote absentee by mail.

Out of Precinct: Required to be absent from my precinct all day on election day (7 am to 7 pm).

Election Official: Perform official acts or duties in connection with the primary or election.

Disabled: Unable to vote in person because of physical disability.

Elderly: 75 years of age or older.
